



It should also be noted that the rankings are based on surveys by numerous entities with different benchmarks and standards, thus caution is needed in their interpretation of final results specially in the case of subjective field matters, as some of these rankings maybe based on speculative, biased, subjective or politicized evaluations. Finally, it is always important to consider <u>trend</u> when making comparisons, since single point data may be exceptional in nature (e.g. Iran's 2008 drought and wheat production).
